Included in this guide, you will find information about the Speech and Language Summer Programs that Providence offers throughout the months of July and August.

Providence Summer Programs are separate from our regular school-based program and are **not funded by Alberta Education Program Unit Funding**. As such, **there is a fee associated with each program**. Children do **not** need to be enrolled in our school-based program to participate.

Payment:

- Payment will only be accepted **after** your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.
- Families may submit receipts to private health insurance providers, FSCD, or other agencies for potential reimbursement. Providence cannot guarantee coverage.

Providence Summer Programs At a Glance

Communication & Play Group	Tues	July 22, 29, Aug 12, 19, 26	A caregiver-and-child group designed to encourage interaction and support early communication skills. Ideal for children who need adult support to participate in large group activities.	\$200
Early Language Explorers Group	Thurs	July 24, 31, Aug 7, 14, 21	A caregiver-and-child group designed to support speech and language development through play. Ideal for children who communicate intentionally and participate in large group activities with minimal support.	\$140
Speech Sound Skills Group	Thurs	July 24, 31, Aug 7, 14, 21	A caregiver-and-child group designed to support speech sound development through guided practice and structured activities. Ideal for children with speech sound delays who can readily participate in structured speech sound practice.	\$140
Early Communicators Day Camp	Tues - Fri	Aug 5-8	A week-long camp focused on improving communication skills, increasing independence in the classroom, and expanding play skills. Ideal for children who actively engage in classroom activities but may need occasional adult support.	\$300 (Half- day) \$525 (Full- day)
Speech & Language Day Camp	Mon- Fri	Aug 11-15	A week-long camp focused on expanding established language skills, improving pronunciation, and enhancing pretend play and peer interactions. Ideal for children who independently engage in classroom activities and routines, and who actively participate in structured, adult-directed tasks.	\$600



PARENT PROGRAM

Communication and Play Group (Summer 2025)

What is it?

A 5-week program for children (ages 2-7) and their parents or caregivers. It offers hands-on strategies that encourage engagement and interaction, and that support the development of early communication skills. It also provides families with a chance to connect with one another in a supportive and welcoming environment.

Note: A parent or caregiver <u>must</u> attend each session and participate in the activities with their child.

Who is this group for?

This group is designed for children who:

- Have a severe language delay
- Are not yet using words or are just starting to use words
- Need extra support to participate in group activities
- Benefit from play-based, child-led learning experiences

How does my child receive therapy?

- Group circle time including action songs, tickles, bounces, finger plays and shared book reading
- Hands-on practice implementing simple techniques, such as following your child's lead and using "communication temptations"
- Parent education focusing on early communication skills as well as simple strategies that can be used during daily routines and play to encourage the development of these skills

- Payment instructions will be provided after your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.

PARENT PROGRAM

Early Language Explorers Group (Summer 2025)

What is it?

A 5-week program for children (ages 2-7) and their parents or caregivers. It provides engaging, play-based activities that target speech and language skills while giving parents and caregivers strategies they can use to support their child's development at home.

Note: A parent or caregiver <u>must</u> attend each session and participate in the activities with their child.

Who is this group for?

This group is designed for children who:

- Have a speech and/or language delay
- Intentionally communicate their wants and needs
- Readily participate in adult-directed large and small group activities

How does my child receive therapy?

- Large-group circle time including interactive songs, turn-taking games, and stories that support speech and language development
- Small-group, play-based activities that target specific speech and language skills, including
 vocabulary development, increasing sentence length, understanding basic concepts, following
 directions and encouraging peer interactions
- Parents and caregivers learn how to use play to encourage speech and language development at home

- Payment instructions will be provided after your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.

PARENT PROGRAM

Speech Sound Skills Group (Summer 2025)

What is it?

A 5-week program for children (ages 4-7) and their parents or caregivers. It provides structured, play-based activities to help children improve their speech clarity. Parents will receive handson coaching to learn effective cues and strategies, ensuring they can confidently support speech practice at home.

Note: A parent or caregiver <u>must</u> attend each session and participate in the activities with their child.

Who is the group for?

This group is designed for children who:

- Have difficulty producing certain speech sounds (speech sound delay), impacting how easily they are understood
- Communicate their wants and needs using words and/or phrases
- Readily imitate words (repeats words when asked) and can actively engage in structured speech sound practice
- · Independently participate in adult-directed activities

How does my child receive therapy?

- Small-group, play-based activities that encourage sound practice in a fun and interactive way
- Parent coaching and guided practice, ensuring parents feel confident in supporting their child's speech at home
- · A structured home practice plan with simple activities to reinforce progress between sessions

- Payment instructions will be provided after your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.

CAMP

Early Communicators Day Camp (Summer 2025)

What is it?

A week-long day camp led by a registered Speech-Language Pathologist with support from teaching/therapeutic assistants and Speech-Language Pathology practicum students. This camp offers a dynamic and supportive environment where children build confidence in their communication skills, strengthen understanding of classroom routines, and expand their play skills.

Who is this camp for?

This camp is designed for children **ages 3-7** who:

- Have a speech and/or language delay
- Intentionally communicate their wants and needs
- Follow the classroom routine & participate in group activities with occasional support
- Independently explore activities and engage in functional play in group settings



How does my child receive therapy?

Small and large-group activities provide intensive, play-based intervention to assist children in developing their communication and play skills. Skills targeted include:

- Communicating with others for a variety of reasons
- Increasing independence in the classroom
- Taking turns and sharing with peers
- Expanding functional and pretend play skills

- Payment instructions will be provided after your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.

CAMP

Speech & Language Day Camp (Summer 2025)

What is it?

A week-long, full-day camp led by a registered Speech-Language Pathologist, with support from teaching/therapeutic assistants and Speech-Language Pathology practicum students. This camp offers interactive, play-based activities that strengthen speech and language skills and foster meaningful social connections and cooperative play.



This camp is designed for children **ages 4-7** who:

- Have a speech and/or language delay
- Consistently communicate with others for a variety of reasons either verbally or using AAC
- Follow the classroom routine independently
- · Participate in structured, adult-directed activities independently



How does my child receive therapy?

Small and large-group activities provide intensive, play-based intervention to assist children in developing their speech and language skills. The skills targeted will include:

- Using longer, more complex sentences
- Following longer, more complex directions with a variety of concepts
- · Using age-appropriate grammar and vocabulary
- Improving pronunciation skills
- Expanding pretend play and social communication skills

- Payment instructions will be provided after your child's spot is confirmed.
- Detailed receipts, including the ACSLPA Registration Number of the Speech-Language Pathologist providing services, will be issued.
- Register <u>online</u>, email the completed registration form to <u>info@providencechildren.com</u>, or drop off a printed copy at any of our school locations.
- Spaces are limited and filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
